

5.4 WRITTEN REPORT OF ORAL STATEMENT

You represent Michael Morgan, who is accused of the murder of Bridget Wilson. On direct examination, Officer O'Leary has testified to an oral confession by Morgan. The officer's testimony is exactly the same as his report. Only O'Leary and Morgan were present at the time of the interview.

Morgan is 17 years old. This is his first arrest. He finished one year of high school before he dropped out to find work as a day laborer.

Morgan will testify later and will admit telling Officer O'Leary he went to Bridget Wilson's house and found Wilson asleep on the couch. However, he will deny saying any of the other things in the statement. Morgan will testify that he told O'Leary that when he found Wilson asleep on the couch, he turned around and walked out, going to the party by himself.
